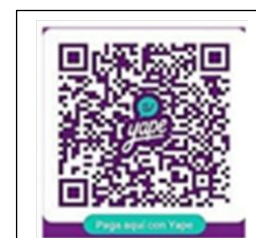

SOCIAL WORK PROJECT

Our main project is to give support to students who have been forced to abandon their higher studies for financial reasons, illness or death in the family or loss of employment. We have 2 we would like to take on;

1. **18 year-old Cairo**, studying in Senati and working part-time in a factory, which covers transport and work materials. His father died last year and his mother went back to the sierra. He lives with an aunt. He is studying Industrial Electricity but cannot now cover the monthly payments. He needs to find 490 soles monthly
2. **20 year-old Sandy**, a single mother with a 4 year-old daughter and a mother who is mentally handicapped and has epilepsy and does not work. Sandy contributes everything; she was getting support from a project but that has just closed down and she is trying to find a part-time job. She is studying to be a nursing technician and has 2 1/2 more years to go.

We usually give around 400 soles monthly to a student and always need more funds. Any small amount is welcome. It all adds up.
